

Policy Statement: Human Subjects Research

I. Preamble:

Scholarly research is a primary method for furthering the College's goals of increasing knowledge and serving the community. When research involves human subjects, however, concerns about protecting the rights and interests of the subjects must be addressed. This policy sets general guidelines to be used by the Human Subject Review Committee (HSRC).

II. Principles:

Any appeal to or use of members of the College community as subjects in research must

through the same channels used to solicit subjects. HSRC will expect to see an account of the debriefing to be employed to provide subjects with accurate information about the research.
